WHAT IS THE HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT?

The state of Alaska's Corporations laws are governed under various legislative enactments. The Alaska Corporation Code is contained in Chapter 6 of Title 10 of the Alaska statutes, entitled "Corporations and Associations." Under the code, a corporation may be organized for any lawful purpose except for the purpose of banking and insurance, both of which are regulated elsewhere under the Alaska statutes.
